## BASIC REQUIREMENTS FOR A CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY (CofO)

- 1. Pass all foundation, framing, insulation, electrical, and plumbing inspections
- 2. Final/CofO inspection selected items to consider:
  - Any decks and porches: If not built before the CofO is issued, a new permit will be required before proceeding
  - b. Staircases with handrails in place
  - c. Sheetrock hung and taped (does not need to be painted)
  - d. No exposed electrical wiring
  - e. Wall plates for switches and outlets must be in place
  - f. Plumbing fixtures installed, including a working sink
  - g. Street address must be posted on house
- 3. Not Required:
  - a. Final floor coverings
  - b. Cabinets/Cupboards
  - c. Light fixtures.
    - i. If not installed, the wires must be enclosed in a covered electrical box
  - d. Stove
  - e. Dishwasher
  - f. Refrigerator
