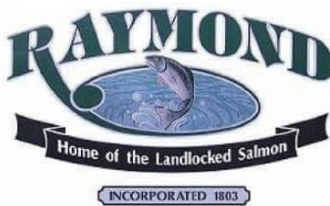

**PERSONAL CAMPSITE

Permission is granted to the above named applicant to maintain a Personal Campsite on the specified property for a period of ninety (90) days only, effective _____. The ninety (90) days will run consecutively unless this office is notified at the start and finish of each non-consecutive period.

The following regulations apply to all personal campsites:

- 1) Personal Campsites are permitted only in the Shoreland Zones
- 2) This permit is restricted to providing temporary accommodation for campers in a recreational vehicle, trailer, or tent used exclusively by the property owner and his or her immediately family. NO RENTALS are permitted.
- 3) Such personal campgrounds shall be limited to no more than one (1) campsite and may not be utilized for more than ninety (90) calendar days per calendar year, including storage of a recreational unit, excepting that the owner of a lot/parcel used as his/her primary residence may store the recreational vehicle(s) or camper(s) owned and registered to him/her.
- 4) If two (2) recreational vehicles or trailers are sited on one lot/parcel, each campsite shall contain at least 30,000 square feet.
- 5) All setback requirements must be met, including awnings, etc.
- 6) In no case shall two campsites comprise more than fifty (50) percent of any lot/parcel, and in no case shall the campsite(s) comprise more than fifty (50) percent of any lot/parcel which also has a seasonal or year round structure on the lot/parcel.
- 7) A permit must be obtained BEFORE the first day of use.
- 8) Size is limited to 280 square feet of floor area measured from the overall outside dimensions.
- 9) All structures must be removed at the end of the ninety (90) days.
- 10) All waste must be disposed of according to all State and Local regulations. A written sewage disposal plan describing the proposed method and location of sewage disposal shall be required for each campsite and shall be approved by the local Plumbing Inspector. Where disposal is off-site, written authorization from the receiving facility or land owner is required.
