

JSMS VISION COMMITTEE MAY 22, 2025 MINUTES 6:00 PM Broadcast Studio & Zoom

- 1. Called to order 6:00 pm
- 2. In attendance: Deb Tarr, Grace Leavitt, Chair Pete Lockwood, Debby Clark, TM Joe Crocker, Sue Accardi, Kaela Gonzalez, Laurie Wallace
- 3. Minutes of 5/12/2025 meeting moved to accept by Grace, seconded by Deb T, unanimously accepted.
- 4. Old Business
 - a. Action Items Update
 - i. Floor plan for existing town office provided by Melissa/Nathan, available for review
 - ii. Committee agreed that first we must prioritize the potential uses before dropping them into a floor plan. Continued discussion as to whether the town offices should be moved to JSMS under one roof with P&R and the Library; most suggest inclusion. Note that available space for town offices is greater than at the existing location.
 - iii. Windham New Building Committee Chair Pete heard from Windham TM Barry Tibbetts. There is only one committee, current plan is to incorporate the Library, P&R and General Assistance. Committee will report out by end of 2025. Outside architectural and design services have already been engaged.
 - iv. SB Chair Rolf Olsen confirmed that this is a short term committee, but if we need a little more time, it would be considered.
 - b. Idea collection and reporting out to the SB Kaela indicated that we really haven't surveyed the town for what the community wants in its center. Grace suggests that the committee first develop a floor plan with existing programs and their space requirements. Chair Pete suggests giving the SB a mission statement, the proposed floor plan, the binder with all hard-copy notes and a summary report. The summary can include recommendations of a survey or public hearing, as well as uses of empty buildings.
