The Board will be asked to select an amount of fund balance to apply towards the municipal budget and approve a tax rate at its September 20, 2022 meeting. Upon approval of the rate, the necessary warrants and certificates may be completed for signatures by the board members the next day. I will be available at the meeting to answer any follow up questions the board may have. --Curt Lebel

The school and town combine for most of the increase. Undesignated Fund Balance is below towns policy of 15% by \$100,000 and we should be adding a little over \$300,000. FY 2022 was a good year for revenues and a bit over for expenses, mostly due to legal fees (which may be recovered at some point). The Select Board by consensus are not pleased that the mill rate needs to be \$15, but there is no choice this year.

She would like to have the town make a statement pertaining to this. The Select Board does not make comments during this segment of the meeting but does acknowledge that unfortunately there are some ignorant people out there.

# Resolution for Reinvesting RVL Funds

#### **MEMO**

October 4, 2022

To: Board of Selectmen

As you may recall, the Raymond Public Library, as part of the MOU and Referendum Question, was to turn over its monetary assets held in their bank account(s) minus \$15,000 for start-up costs. These transactions have occurred. I am seeking approval to invest the balance the library previously had in an account held by Key Bank Mutual Funds (\$129,633.75) and invest these funds with MBS Multi-Bank Securities, Inc. I solicitated recommendations from other municipalities, and this was the firm that was recommended from those that responded. I had also contacted Norway Savings Bank Asset Group Management however they have a minimum balance requirement and charge a management fee. MBS Multi-Bank Securities does not have a minimum balance requirement, nor do they charge any fees. They also provide third party safekeeping, statements, confirms, and portfolio analysis. Other municipalities in Maine that use MBS are Waterville, Ellsworth, and Falmouth.

There is a Non-Corporation Form that typically is signed by the Town Clerk to certify the meeting date and the action taken.
