1) Called to order at 6:30pm by Selectman Olsen

Welcome to Joe Bruno and congratulations on his election. Thank you to Marshall Bullock for his time on the Select Board.

2) Minutes of previous meetings

a) May 11, 2021

Motion to approve as presented by Selectman Sadak. Seconded by Selectman Taylor.

3) New Business

a) Election of Officers

Motion to elect Teresa Sadak for Chair by Selectman Bruno. Seconded by Selectman Taylor.

Motion to elect Rolf Olsen for Vice-Chair by Selectman Taylor. Seconded by Selectman Gifford.

Motion to elect Joe Bruno for Parliamentarian by Selectman Sadak. Seconded by Selectman Taylor.

b) <u>Consideration of Recycler License for Automill LLC at 1261 Roosevelt Trail</u> – Alex Sirois, CEO

This is the annual renewal.

There has been a complaint that they have exceeded the 20 car maximum allowed on their license and CEO Sirois did not find this to be true then. Tonight, they had 35 cars.

Sarah Day of Automill said that the resale vehicles do not count, nor do any sold vehicles. They can have 20 parts cars and up to 10 for resale or sold cars. CEO Sirois will look into this. Automill had a "deal with the old CEO".

Automill has a used cars license and a recycler's license.

The Select Board would like CEO Sirois to make sure what the limits are and what the authority is.

CEO Sirois will review the ZBA determination. There is no urgency to renew this license.

Motion to approve with all applicable limits by Selectman Bruno. Seconded by Selectman Olsen.

 d) <u>Consideration of Appointing Greg Dean to the Zoning Board of Appeals</u> – Alex Sirois, CEO

Mr Dean wants to be involved in the community and has attended a ZBA meeting and a site walk.

Thank you for stepping up and volunteering.

Motion to appoint Greg Dean to the ZBA for a term ending 6/30/2022 by Selectman Bruno. Seconded by Selectman Gifford.

e) <u>Consideration of Resignation of Len Cirelli from the Zoning Board of Appeals</u> – Alex Sirois, CEO

Motion to accept Mr Cirelli's resignation from the ZBA by Selectman Olsen. Seconded by Selectman Taylor.

f) <u>Consideration of Absorbing Raymond Recreation Assets</u> – Joe Crocker, Parks & Rec Director; Alex Aponte, Finance Director; and Raymond Recreation Representative

The Raymond Recreation Board has decided to dissolve and transfer their funds and assets to the Town of Raymond. The funds they want ear-tagged for a facility. They will still help out with how they have run the programs and parents will still be asked to volunteer to coach, etc.

Motion to absorb the assets of Raymond Recreation and set up a special revenue fund to be carried forward by Selectman Bruno. Seconded by Selectman Gifford.

By consensus the board agreed that they would go back to an in-person meeting in July and a letter will be sent to the other Town committees/boards/commissions that they must stop the electronic meeting after July 31st.

h) Consideration of Annual Payroll Warrant Policy – Alex Aponte, Finance Director

Purpose	To allow at least one (1) of the municipal officers to review, approve, and sign the treasurer's payroll warrants, and		
	to allow a <u>majority of</u> the municipal officers to review, approve, and sign the treasurer's accounts payable warrants.		
Delegation of Authority	This policy allows at least one (1) of the municipal officers (selectmen), acting on behalf of the full board of municipal officers, to review, approve, and sign municipal treasurer's disbursement warrants for employee wages and benefits (pursuant to 30-A MRSA § 5603 (2)(A)(1)).		
	This policy further allows at least a majority of the municipal officers (selectmen), acting on behalf of the full board of municipal officers, to review, approve, and sign municipal treasurer's accounts payable warrants (pursuant to 30-A MRSA § 5603 (2)(A)).		
Majority Power	This policy is in addition to, not in lieu of, majority power. Nothing in this policy is intended to replace the authority of the full board of municipal officers, acting by majority vote, to act on any treasurer's warrant, including warrants for payroll and for accounts payable.		
Original & Copy	The original document will be filed annually with the Town Clerk and a copy will be filed with the Treasurer.		
Lapse	This policy lapses annually on June 30th, if not sooner amended or canceled.		
Renewal	This policy may be renewed at any time before its lapse. Thereafter it may be readopted at any time. Any renewal is valid until June 30th of the next fiscal year.		
Effective Date:	July 1, 2021 End Date: June 30, 2022

4) Public Comment

Selectman Bruno thanked the residents of the Town of Raymond for electing him to a 5th term as Selectman. He really missed it while he was gone and is excited to be back.

Selectman Olsen thanked the Town Staff for their efforts during the COVID-19 pandemic. They managed to serve the Town very well during tough times.

Selectman Gifford said that he felt it was time to review the Comprehensive Plan.

Chair Sadak clarified that the Select Board has checked into a number of places to create a Raymond Community Center. The Town has not been offered land for this purpose. We do not want to make a bad investment for the Town and we do continue to look for an opportunity.

Selectman Bruno requested that a Comprehensive Plan discussion be added to the next agenda. Selectman Gifford and Taylor agreed. Chair Sadak asked that it be added.

6) Town Manager's Report and Communications

Town Manager Willard – I have been working with Kevin Woodbrey, and Laurie Forbes to try to push broadband forward. We have made several unsuccessful applications, but it is highly competitive for towns to get grant monies for this. We did get a small grant at one point. We are hopeful that the County will put some of their American Rescue Plan grant monies toward this. I agree that we need this and when there is something to report I will get it out there.

We are doing a lot of roadside mowing with our large mower and drainage improvements. We are waiting for the MEDOT to give the green light to begin the Main Street sidewalk program. We need more call members for Public Safety.
