

June 14, 1993 Minutes of the Tassel Top Committee

Due to poor weather conditions on opening day the gate receipts totaled only \$24.00.

It was decided that when Tassel Top is open a ranger must be on duty. At the ranger's discretion, pending weather conditions, he may close the park.

A drinking fountain with a bubbler will be installed at the base of the hill near the snack bar.

The snack bar is not complete at this time. It needs electricity. Food cannot be prepared at the snack bar. They will sell charcoal, ice cream bars and all packaged foods.

We were over-budgeted on the snack bar and so will not be able to do anything with the gate.

The T shirt design was tabled until next year.

The house is ready for rental. The number of occupants will be limited to 6 and no pets will be allowed. They can arrive on Saturday at 2:00 p.m. and will leave on the following Saturday at 10:00 a.m. The rental fee will be \$400. per week. If the house is not reserved, it can be rented for one night at \$150. Martin Krauter will draw up the contract. All rentals for the house will be handled by Norman Ridlon. The Town Office will take the telephone numbers of applicants and relay that information to Norman. The deposit fee will be \$200. and the balance will be due on arrival.
