

May 23, 1994 Minutes of the Tassel Top Committee

Present: Charles Smith, Chairperson, Robert Metz, Norman Ridlon,
and Martin Krauter.

Mr. Robert Jones attended the meeting to address the committee on the rental of the cabin for the Labor Day Weekend- Friday through Monday. Our policy is consistent with the normal rental week in a resort area - Saturday 3:00 pm to Saturday 10:00 am.

Mrs. Ellen Williams of the Raymond Extended Day Inc., a non-profit private organization addressed the committee on renting the cabin during the week (7:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.), for approximately 20 children. We rent the cabin to 6-8 people at a fee of \$400. This organization could not afford the fee. Mrs. Williams will report this information to the school board and hopefully they can make arrangements at the school for this group.

The April 4, 1994 minutes were approved as read.

Old Business:

The committee now has a drafted rental lease. Mr. Krauter will have a lease prepared for our next meeting.

New Business:

It was recommended that a telephone be put in the lodge with an extension in the snack bar for emergency calls. This will be approved at the next meeting.

Reservations for the use of the cabin after the regular season will be made with the Ranger prior to Labor Day Weekend.

The Tassel Top Beach will open on Saturday, May 28, Memorial Day Weekend. The snack bar will not be open the first two weeks of June.

We no longer have ^{individual} seasonal passes. All vehicles have a sticker and second stickers may be purchased for \$5.00. ←

The Ranger requested that we establish a policy regarding the closing of the beach because of inclement weather. The general feeling was that it should be open every day. This issue will be discussed when we have a full committee.

A Tassel Top brochure was discussed and we will have some galleys prepared for a future meeting.

The committee will look for a run-about boat and motor for use in setting out bouys, etc.
