

March 15, 1995 Minutes of the Tassel Top Committee.

Present: Robert Metz, Chairperson, Stephen Crockett, Donna Johnson, Martin Krauter and Charles Smith.

The agenda was approved with the addition of a request by CMP.

The February 15, 1995 minutes were approved.

Old Business:

The committee reviewed the 1995 budget with Martin Krauter. Park admissions were reviewed:

Salaries for Tassel Top employees were discussed: Ranger \$7.50 per hour, staff returning \$6.91 and new staff \$6.50. The staff will consist of 4½ people, Ranger (hours 9 - 8, six days a week), Ass't. Ranger, and 2 gate keepers (6 hour shift). The season will start in mid-June and extend through Labor Day. Donna Johnson made a motion that the hours for a manned gate will be 10:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m., 4:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m. Honor System. The motion was seconded and passed. After more discussion on salaries, a motion was made and passed that new staff would receive \$5.50 per hour and returning staff \$6.91. Martin Krauter will advertise April 1st for a Ranger. The 1995 budget was approved.

Charles Smith presented a draft of the Tassel Top Committee Report. The inclusion of the terms of the committee members will be included. The report was approved by the committee.

A light installed at the Tassel Top Beach was discussed. M. Krauter has been working on this with the D.O.T.

The committee is still hoping that the Recreation Swimming Program will be held at Tassel Top. A suggestion was made that the children who pass their swimming classes would receive a free pass to T.T.B.

Several changes were made on the Tassel Top Brochure. The committee authorized spending \$400. for the brochure printing. This will include a donation to the Club.

New Business:

Central Maine Power has requested a proposed power line into Tassel Top Park. The committee is open to a discussion with CMP (underground wiring or an easement) but is not considering utility poles in the park.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:38 p.m.
