

July 11, 1995 Minutes of the Tassel Top Committee

Present: Robert Metz, Chairperson, Stephen Crockett, Donna Johnson, Martin Krauter, Jim Lewis, Steve Swick, Ranger and, guest Harold Burnham of Wind In the Pines.

The agenda was approved.

The minutes of June 13, 1995, were approved.

Old Business:

Ranger Swick reports that LouAnn Milton replaced Cynthia Bagley as a gate keeper. Gate keepers have been needed from 9:00 - 5:00. To date, the honor box has not been used. Gate keepers have been kept to a maximum 20 hour week.

The trail to the beach has been covered with hay and closed at the top with a new fence. Hopefully this will discourage dirt bikers from using it. A weed wacker has been procured and the old lawn mower has been upgraded to a better one.

The committee had hoped to use vending machines as a replacement for a park attendant in the snack bar. However, vending machines are not available for a 2 month rental. The snack bar was sub-contracted to Heidi Pomerleau for 10% of her profit. To date, it is working very well and is a clean operation.

New Business:

A car was broken into and a purse and camera were stolen. Rangers will keep a sharp eye and ask Sherrifs to swing by occasionally. It was suggested that nothing of value be left visible in the car.

Mr. Burnham was introduced and as he has a common interest in keeping boats off the beach area, he offered a sign "No Boats" that will be placed in the buffer zone between the two properties. Thank you Mr. Burnham.

It was suggested that the rangers spot check new faces to make sure that they aren't "crashers" coming on the property.

Neighbor C. Mason has been concerned with the numbers in the Park. He was told that when the parking lot is full the gate is closed and that there is no number of 300 as the limit.

A Tassel Top revenue control report was not available at this meeting but will be available at the next meeting.

There is no phone in the cabin. The phone in the gate keeper's hut is available for emergencies; otherwise there is a phone at ShurFine Foods. We will run a cabin rental for a week in two newspapers for the open last week in August and first week in September.
