February 25, 1997

Minutes of the October 29, 1996, meeting were approved.

Another assistant ranger will be needed. N. Poore suggested that
we look at staff who are returning this summer. Pat Peluso will
be returning as an assistant ranger this summer, indicating to
B. Metz that he will work more hours. The staff consists of 6;
1 Ranger, 2 Asst. Rangers, and 3 gatekeepers.

The Tassel Top Cabin Agreement was approved by the committee with
the stipulation that the Town Attorney would check it. Vern will
check out arrangements for key drop-off when cabin renters leave.

N. Poore suggested that we ^{have} more information for the Website. D. Johnson
will supply information and pictures.

New Tassel Top stickers will be ordered and the color will be changed.
They will be sold at Town Hall and Tassel Top.

B. Metz suggested that each of the committee members have an
individual responsibility to the Park. Areas were assigned as follows:

- B. Metz will be the liaison between N. Poore and the committee
- J. Lewis will oversee the rental cabin
- S. Crockett will work with the snack bar and special projects
- D. Johnson - Website

Zack Swick would like to do a pavillion in the Park as an Eagle
Scout project. The committee would like him to submit a plan.

A committee meeting will be held on March 25, Tues., 7:00 p.m. at
Town Hall for the sole purpose of discussing long range plans for
the Park.

An on-site meeting at Tassel Top in conjunction with the long range
plan will be held on Sunday, April 6th at 9:00 a.m.

S. Crockett commented on the many people who told him they so
enjoyed the friendly relationship at Tassel Top. The labor costs
were kept down and D. Johnson felt the committee had done a good job.

at Town Hall.
