- 7. The mowing machine is still an issue, but for the time being the school machine will be used. Nathan requested that the machine be serviced and returned in good condition.
- 8. Mike presented a promotional "Honor Roll Weekend" for June 25-26. Any honor roll student and accompanying adult admitted for 1/2 price during the day which was approved. He also suggested hosting a Labor Day Yard Sale which was approved.
