New business:

- 1. A motion to appoint Susan LaMarre as Park Ranger for the current year was seconded and approved.
- 2. Permission was given for Susan to grant raises (at her discretion) to returning employees. Raises are given based on job performance and experience, and in consultation with Nancy Yates at the town office.
- 3. A discussion was held concerning dogs in the park. Susan says owners are walking dogs off leash and not cleaning up after them. Reports of out of town dog walkers was also noted. Although a sign is posted that dogs are not permitted, it is still used after hours and throughout the year. It was agreed than an official and permanent sign be purchased and erected at the entrance.
- 4. A review of the Sebago Lake Rotary's fishing derby use of the park this past winter concluded satisfactorily. There was no significant damage this year. One lingering fishing shack floated onto the beach and was eventually removed by the owner, with apologies.
- 5. With the donation of a refridgerator for the snack shack from Bob Yates at Sears, "fast franks" will be on sale this season--a much requested snack from customers each year.
