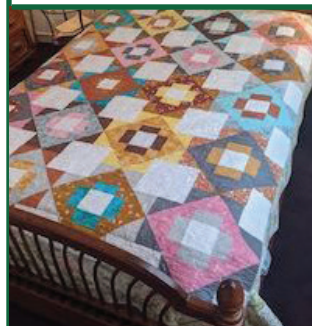

This year we will be taking pre-orders for Holiday Cookies to be picked up on Sunday, December 20th from 11pm – 1pm

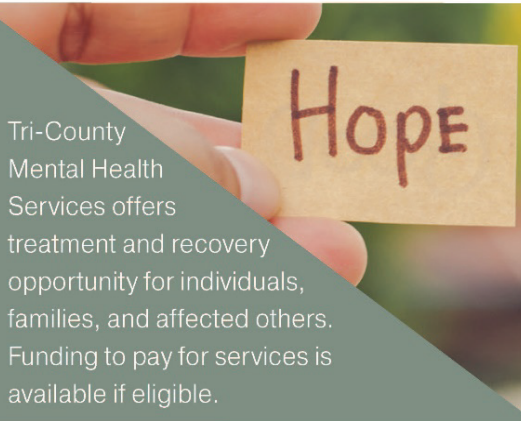

Winter Sand & Salt Shed

THE SAND & SALT SHED ON PLAINS ROAD (FL 89) IS NOW OPEN TO RAYMOND RESIDENTS FOR THOSE WHO WISH TO GET SAND FOR USE ON RESIDENTIAL DRIVEWAYS. The small wooden shed for residential use is located just inside the gate to the right. Hours open are Monday-Friday 7am to 3pm, unless during a snow storm due to plow truck traffic. Residents should expect to get no more than a couple 5-gallon buckets at a time. Please note that all other areas of Public Works yard are not for resident use. *If you have any questions, contact Public Works Director, Nathan White at 207-653-3641.*
