- We have rented out the entirety of Messer Hall to have access to the whole building, kitchen, and lounge area. This also allows us to increase the number of campers that can attend every week.
- **New group structure:** We will be putting campers in consistent groups led by a Senior Counselor and supported by a Junior Counselor. Groups are subject to change bi-weekly as we expect some variation in registration for campers who do not attend for the full 8 weeks, but our goal is consistency.

NOMINATION PAPERS ARE AVAILABLE AT THE TOWN OFFICE, AND ARE DUE BACK BY APRIL 12, 2024, AT 4:00PM FOR THE FOLLOWING OFFICES:

- Select Board 1 member for a 3-year term
- Budget-Finance Committee 3 members for 3-year terms
- RSU #14 Board of Directors 1 member for a 3-year term

At least 25 registered voters must sign the nomination papers for a candidate to appear on the ballot at the June 11, 2024, Election.

PROPERTY TAX **EXEMPTIONS**

Did you know the State of Maine provides property tax relief through different programs to qualified individuals? Below is a list of property tax exemptions that may qualify you for a discount off your total assessed tax value.

Applications due NO LATER THAN April 1st, 2024

HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION

This program provides a measure of property tax relief for certain individuals that have owned homestead property in Maine for at least 12 months and make the property they occupy on April 1 their permanent residence.

VETERAN'S EXEMPTION

A veteran who served during a recognized war period and is 62 years or older; or, is receiving 100% disability as a Veteran; or became 100% disabled while serving, is eligible for a tax exemption.

Veteran must be listed as a co-owner on the deed. **BLIND EXEMPTION**

An individual who is determined to be legally blind may receive a tax exemption. Individual must be listed as a co-owner on the deed.

*Exemption amounts will vary year to year based on the towns certified ratio.

The Mongol Derby with Jessie Dowling Thursday April 11th at 5pm

Jessie will share photos and stories from the 2023 Mongol Derby, "the longest and toughest horse race in the world", an endurance race across Mongolia that follows the messenger system created by Ghengis Khan.

Worm Bin Composting Workshop with Vermiculturist Jock Robie Saturday April 27th 1-3pm

Mr. Robie will supply all the equipment needed to start 5 worm bins at no charge. A lottery will be held to see who gets to take them home (1 per household). Topics will include definitions of worm composting and vermiculture, the benefits of work composting, things to consider before starting, and what it takes for worms to thrive along with common problems. Attendees will work in teams to set up the worm bins, which will be due for the first harvest in 3 to 4 months at a follow-up class. Mr. Robie will stay in touch with each participating household during the first year until participants are self-reliant.
