

**TOWN OF RAYMOND

PUBLIC SAFETY DEPARTMENT**

NATURE OF WORK:

This position requires the employee to respond to a wide variety of medical and trauma emergencies. Required to respond to emergencies in all weather, and due to geography, the employee must be ready for emergencies in water, on thin ice, rural terrain and developed residential and commercial areas of town.

An Employee of this class has responsibility for responding to, performing the duties of and working to their EMS license level under protocols as defined by MEMS. Responds to all department fire and rescue calls as they are scheduled. While on a call reports directly to the crew leader or officer on the call.

ESSENTIAL SKILLS: (Illustrative Only)

Performs routine equipment checks and documents this activity and writes up a work order form

Must have a good understanding of the geography of the Town

Must maintain a thorough knowledge of department regulations and operational guidelines

Writes official reports for Department business, and completes State run reports

Must be able to make calm rational decisions in abnormal situations

Must understand a paramilitary chain of command and work well within the system

Must be energetic, self-motivated, and able to do work without direct supervision

Uses knowledge appropriately to solve a wide variety of problems

Must hold or obtain firefighter one certification within one year of hire

Performs general cleaning of stations, station grounds and apparatus

Performs daily equipment checks and documents this activity

Must become proficient in operating all department apparatus within six months of hire

Attend department EMS trainings as needed to keep skill level up and EMS license valid

Must meet NIMS compliancy as required for their position

Work as a team with other crew members to get vehicles restocked, cleaned and paperwork and reports finished for each call

In order to be cleared for driving the ambulance must meet and follow all Driver/Operator Guidelines in section 1.7 in the SOG manual

Must have the physical strength and agility sufficient for performing EMS duties as outlined by the department's JPA

Must be a team player who communicates issues using the proper chain of command

Must have a valid EMT License
