

**TOWN OF RAYMOND
OPERATOR/LABORER/MAINTENANCE
PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT**

This is manual labor performing various tasks and operating equipment used in road construction, maintenance and repair and in the snow plowing and removal operations of the Public Works Department.

An employee of this class is responsible for participating in a wide range of manual activities related to the maintenance of roads and other public facilities. The employee works under the direct supervision of the Public Works Director. Work involves the use of different tools and equipment. Work instructions are received in detail for each job to be performed or may follow an established routine: Work is subject to review while in progress and upon completion by the Public Works Director.

EXAMPLES OF WORK (illustrative only)

Performs varied maintenance work including rebuilding storm drains and culverts, patching and building roads, and other general duties

Picks up debris such as blow downs, brush, and trash

Straightens signs and posts

Maintains equipment in satisfactory working condition and sets up equipment for various seasonal uses

Assists in general repair and maintenance on vehicles and equipment and assists in general maintenance of Public Works garage

Operates a moderately heavy-duty truck transporting various materials and assists in the loading and unloading of trucks

Operates trucks and sanders for plowing, sanding and snow removal operations of Town roads

Assists in the general maintenance of municipal facilities such as recreation areas, parks, cemeteries, and town buildings

Performs related work as required

REQUIREMENTS OF WORK

Ability to safely operate trucks and other medium and heavy equipment in accordance with all applicable laws and regulations

Ability to make minor repairs and adjustments and service vehicles and equipment
Ability to perform manual labor for extended periods of time under adverse weather conditions

DESIRABLE EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING

High school graduation and experience in the operation and maintenance of medium and heavy-duty trucks and equipment; a clean driving record; possession of a valid Class A or B motor vehicle operator's license, CDL license, or any equivalent combination of experience and training
