

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) - MSW & RECYCLING CURBSIDE COLLECTION

Issued: October 22, 2025

Bids Due: November 13, 2025

Town of Raymond, Maine

1. Overview

The Town of Raymond, Maine is requesting sealed proposals for the provision of Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) and Zero-Sort Recycling Collection Services. The Town seeks a qualified contractor to provide reliable, efficient, and responsible curbside and dumpster collection for designated municipal sites and residents. The Town is open to considering alternative collection methods that improve efficiency, sustainability, or cost-effectiveness, provided all minimum service standards are met.

2. Scope of Services

The selected contractor shall provide weekly collection and disposal services for municipal solid waste and zero-sort recycling. Services shall include curbside collection along approved routes as well as dumpster collection at 8 specified municipal sites.

Dumpster Collection Sites:

- Shaw Road – 2 dumpsters
- Musson Road – 2 dumpsters
- Dryad Woods Road – 2 dumpsters
- Cattle Road – 1 dumpster
- Notched Pond Road – 2 dumpsters
- Whispering Pines Road – 1 dumpster
- Public Safety Building – 2 dumpsters
- Plains Road – 4 dumpsters

Collection Days: Monday through Thursday. Each day will cover designated routes as shown on the attached Trash Route Map. Routes remain the same during summer and winter seasons.

Holidays (no collection): Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day.

Average Weekly Tonnage (2024):

- 33 tons Municipal Solid Waste (MSW)
- 7.5 tons Zero-Sort Recycling

3. Proposal Requirements

Each proposer must submit one (1) original and two (2) copies of their proposal in a sealed envelope marked "Curbside Recycling & Solid Waste Proposal." Electronic submissions via email are also accepted if received prior to the deadline.

Proposals must include:

- Company name, address, and contact information
- Description of experience with municipal waste collection
- List of vehicles and equipment to be used

- Staffing and operational plan
- Proposed schedule and cost proposal
- References from at least three (3) client

4. Insurance and Bonding

Before commencing work, the successful proposer shall furnish proof of insurance, including general liability, automobile, worker's compensation, and environmental liability coverage. A performance bond equal to one (1) year's contract value shall be required prior to the start of service.

5. Evaluation Criteria

Proposals will be evaluated based on the following factors:

- Cost competitiveness
- Reliability and demonstrated experience
- Sustainability and recycling performance
- Quality of equipment and personnel
- References and past performance

6. Site Visits

Proposers are strongly encouraged to visit all collection sites to familiarize themselves with local conditions and site logistics. Failure to inspect the sites will not relieve the successful proposer from any obligations under the contract.

7. Submission Details

Sealed bids must be received at the Raymond Town Office, 401 Webbs Mills Road, Raymond, Maine 04071, no later than 9:00 AM on Thursday, November 13, 2025. Bids may be delivered in person or mailed; no email submissions will be accepted. Bids will be opened publicly on Thursday, November 13, 2025, at 10:00 AM at the Raymond Broadcast Studio, 423 Webbs Mills Road, Raymond, Maine.

Trash & Recycling Collection Policy

1. Pick up will be Monday through Thursday, each day collects one area of town. (See collection map for details.)
 2. The Holiday Schedule changes year to year. Please contact the Town or more information.
 3. The collection will be the same winter and summer.
 4. Have all trash/recycling curbside by 7:00 a.m.
 5. Barrel(s) not be to over 32 gallons in size.
 6. Have street address on outside of the barrel(s).
 7. No filled barrel can weigh over 50 pounds.
 8. Have all trash in bags and inside barrel(s).
 9. Trash and recycling will be picked up at different times on your collection day.
 10. All trash/recycling from private roads must be left curbside at the next major private road or town road. (Exceptions, please see road list.)
 11. Collection Route Map is on display at the Town Office and the website www.raymondmaine.org
- Households with excess trash can purchase trash bag stickers at the Town Office for \$1 each.
