# **Town of Raymond Award & Scholarship Requirements**

## **Alva M. Clough Scholarship – EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP**

1. Must reside in Raymond.
2. Must make application by letter stating his/her plans for their future in the field of education.
3. Must be accepted by a four-year college.
4. Must submit current educational attainment and grade transcripts.
5. Must have recommendations from the Guidance Counselor, a teacher of his/her secondary school, and a person in Raymond who knows his/her family which will include reference to his/her character and personality qualifications as well as a record of ability and achievement.
6. Payment will be made to recipients upon the receipt of a transcript from their school after the first semester which shows their achievement of a passing grade.

## **Carlton E. Edwards Scholarship – GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP**

1. \$500.00 scholarship.
2. Must reside in Raymond, and preference will be given to a North Raymond student if equally qualified.
3. Must make application by letter stating his/her plans.
4. Must be accepted by a four-year college.
5. An applicant can be eligible for the scholarship for more than one year if he/she is qualified, but a new application must be filed each year.
6. Must submit current educational attainment and grade transcripts.
7. Payment will be made to recipients upon the receipt of a transcript from their school after the first semester (after the scholarship is awarded) which shows their achievement of a passing grade.

## **Collins-Day Scholarship – GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP**

1. Must reside in Raymond, have graduated from a high school or academy, and continuing education at a college or technical school.
2. Must make application by letter stating his/her plans.
3. Must submit current educational attainment and grade transcripts.
4. Must have recommendations from the Guidance Counselor, a teacher of his/her secondary school, and a person in Raymond who knows his/her family which will include reference to his/her character and personality qualifications as well as a record of ability and achievement.
5. Payment will be made to recipients upon the receipt of a transcript from their school after the first semester which shows their achievement of a passing grade.

## **George E. Wood Memorial Scholarship – MATHEMATICS SCHOLARSHIP**

1. Must reside in Raymond
2. Must make application by letter stating his/her plans.
3. Must be accepted by a school: college or technical/vocational school.
4. Must submit current educational attainment and grade transcripts.
5. Must have recommendations from the Guidance Counselor, a mathematics teacher of his/her secondary school, and from a person in Raymond who knows his/her family which will include reference to his/her character and personality qualifications as well as a record of ability and achievement in the field of mathematics.
6. Payment will be made to recipients upon the receipt of a transcript from their school after the first semester which shows their achievement of a passing grade.
